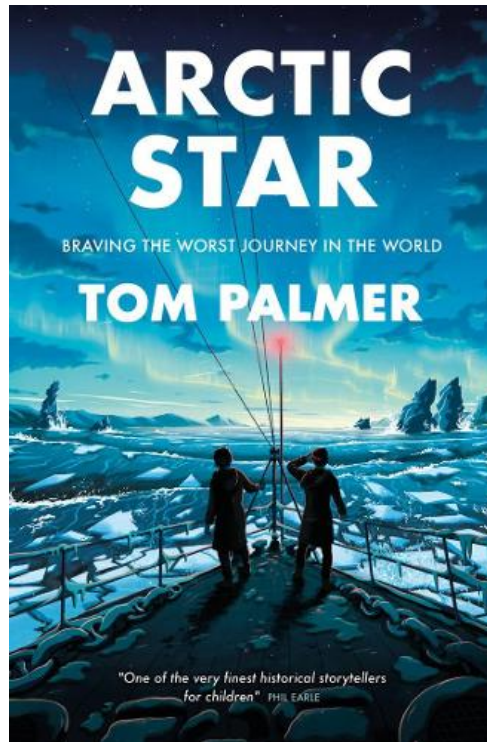
We made a boo boo!
