RNA AGM AND CONFERENCE AND BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC COMMEMORATIONS The 2023 RNA AGM/Conference will be held in Liverpool over the weekend 26-28 May 2023. The Battle of Atlantic 80th (BoA80) commemorations take place concurrently with Shipmates included as they wish (the RNA is embedded in Naval Regional Commander led plans). Area 10 are also putting together golf on the Friday, plus fabulous Adelphi Hotel based entertainment on the Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights. ARMED FORCES COVENANT AND VETERANS ANNUAL REPORT The 2022 Armed Forces Covenant and Veterans Annual Report was published on 19 December 2022, covering the period of 2021 to 2022. This is the 11th Annual Report on the Armed Forces Covenant since its introduction as a statutory requirement in the Armed Forces Act 2011, and it is the second

integrated report between the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Office for Veterans' Affairs (OVA) in the Cabinet Office. The press release from the MoD can be seen here, a summary of the report can be accessed here and the full report (lengthy!) can be found here.

LORNA COCKAYNE The RNA learnt late last month of the sad passing of Lorna Cockayne, one of the last living WRNS member that served as a code-breaker at Bletchley Park during the Second World War. In 2021 and in recognition of her work, the French government appointed her to the Légion d'honneur, one of its highest awards. She was presented with her medal by Commodore (now Rear Admiral) Jude Terry. Lorna's story is fascinating, a little of which is described in her Daily Telegraph obituary here. RIP Lorna and thank you. She is pictured below on the left after the award of the Légion d'honneur and on the right as a young Wren during her time at Bletchley Park.
