SAILOR SOLDIERS RNA members were out in force to help in the dedication of a national monument to the Royal Naval Division (RND). This unit, initially formed of sailors who had not yet been allocated to a ship, served with distinction in the trenches of the Western Front and Gallipoli in World War 1, and in 1925 a memorial in the form of a fountain was erected in their honour on Horse Guards Parade, just off Whitehall in London, marking the tenth anniversary of the Gallipoli landings. In the intervening years the monument was moved during World War 2 as part of building work on the Admiralty Citadel, and it only returned to Whitehall from Greenwich in 2003.
