FULL CIRCLE On 17 March an extraordinary maritime expedition will set sail from Falmouth. Full Circle is a 2,000nm voyage around the coastline of the UK, uniting adventure, heritage and veteran recovery. Organised by the veterans' sailing charity Turn to Starboard in partnership with The Invictus Games Birmingham 2027, the 13-week journey will see two tall ships visit 22 ports across England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the Isle of Man. Crewed by 70 wounded, injured and sick veterans from the UK and overseas, the expedition is designed to inspire confidence, purpose and connection through life at sea.

The five-leg expedition includes stops at Plymouth, Weymouth, Portsmouth, Ramsgate Chatham, Ipswich, Hull, Newcastle, Leith, Wick, Stromness, Stornoway, Summer Isles, Oban, Bangor NI, Peel IOM, Liverpool, Milford Haven, and the Isles of Scilly . At each stop there will be engagement with veterans, the community, schools, defence and maritime organisations.
