ARCTIC ACTIVITIES Royal Navy and Royal Marines units have been practising their Arctic combat and logistics skills in the far north of Norway under a new agreement between the nations that will help defend the northern flank of NATO. Commando units, ships and helicopters have been involved in the long-running Operation Clockwork, preparing British forces for the wider, large-scale multinational Exercise Cold Response. The new agreement will see British cold-weather specialists work and train alongside their Norwegian counterparts all year round as they step up readiness to war-fight alongside allies in the High North.
