



Minutes of

5. Items discussed at Committee Meeting

Area 4 Webmaster - S/M Bob Featherstone has now taken over the reins of Area 4 Website. All News items and important 'In Memoriam' notices that are for the Area Website should continue to be channelled through him as Branch PRO.

Guest of Honour for Trafalgar Night Dinner 2026 - S/M Nige Rimell has suggested that his ex-Flight Commander from HMS London, Cdr Louis Wilson-Chalon (RNR) be our Guest of Honour. The Committee were in agreement and details to be passed to the Secretary for a formal invitation to be sent.

Bank Charges – S/M Pete Shoemsmith stated that cheques now cost 50p each to be paid in and also to be sent from the account. The Post Office have been told by Lloyds Bank not to accept cheques for paying in. Cash payments are now preferred.

Rig for General Branch Meetings – S/M Dusty Miller suggested that rather than wear full rig for our General Branch Meetings he has purchased an RNA polo shirt. The Secretary's Guide suggested more informal dress so he was following this advice. If others wished to continue with full rig then he was fine with that idea.
